


the symbol.




when the logo is used on a background that is darker than 50% gray, reverse the type to white for legibility.



in black and white reproduction, use the black and white version of the logo.


clear space

bad logo usage



never switch the colors.



never use the logo on similar colored backgrounds. unless the background color is Pantone® 2935 and the logotype is white.



never rearrange the elements of the logo.



never stray from the color palette.



never stretch or distort the logo.
